- Please do not bring any toys unless asked for special occasions.

Harvest Morning Out Mission Statement: Harvest Morning out is a family ministry program that provides Jesus-centered childcare for families from the church and community. Our goal is to provide a safe place for kids to be kids, while also giving parents and caregivers the extra support that they need. We strive to promote growth in all areas of development including intellectual, social, emotional, physical, and spiritual through various activities.

Medication: No medication will be administered to any child without specific instructions from a parent, a physician, or other authorized health professional. Prescribed medications should be in its original container bearing the pharmacist's label which lists the child's name, date prescription was filled, physician's name, name of medication, directions for dosage and written instructions from the physician, signed and dated. Over-the-counter medication should be in its original bottle and be accompanied by written instructions from parent and be signed and dated.

No medication given shall exceed amounts and frequency of dosage specified in the printed instructions accompanying the medication.

Sick Policy:

Any Child that:

- Has a temperature of 100.5 or above; or
- Has the sudden onset of diarrhea characterized by an increased number of bowel movements compared to the child's normal pattern and with increased stool water; or
- Has two or more episodes of vomiting within a 12 hour period; or
- Has red eye with white or yellow eye discharge until 24 hours after treatment; or
- Has scabies or lice; or
- Has known chicken pox or a rash suggestive of chicken pox; or
- Has strep throat, until 24 hours after treatment has started; or
- Has hepatitis A virus infection, until one week after onset of illness; or
- Jaundice; or
- Has a physician's or other health professional's written order that the child be separated from other children is not allowed in the center.

If a child becomes sick during the day the parent will be called immediately to pick up the child.
